

Immigration regulations state: "For F-1 students enrolled in classes for credit or classroom hours, no more than the equivalent of one class or three credits per session, term, semester, trimester or quarter may be counted toward the full course of study requirement if the class is taken online or through distance education and does not require the student's physical attendance for classes, examination or other purposes integral to completion of the class." (8 C.F.R. § 214.2 (f)(6)(i)(G))

To compensate for the online courses, Florida Tech has created this form to allow students taking an online course to count the course as an on-campus course and not an online course to comply with their full-time enrollment requirement. This form should be filled out and signed by the course instructor and returned to the DSO at FIT Orlando during the first week of classes for a given term.
