

Review all following information carefully. Then return it with your tuition deposit (if applicable) to the address below. Retain the white copy for your records.

IMPORTANT: By now you should have received an e-mail regarding the activation of your TRACKS account. The e-mail was sent to the address you provided on your application. Once you have activated your TRACKS account, you can log on any-time to Panther Pass (<https://pantherpass.fit.edu>) in order to:

- Pay your tuition deposit
- Pay your housing deposit
- Confirm or decline attendance to Florida Tech
- Access health and other required enrollment forms
- Obtain housing and meal plan information

FINANCIAL AID: All students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid by March 1 of their senior year. Florida Tech uses FAFSA information to help determine financial aid packages (which include scholarships, grants, work-study, etc.) for all students, regardless of need. Florida Tech's FAFSA school code is 001469. Apply online: www.fafsa.ed.gov.

TUITION DEPOSIT: A \$300 nonrefundable tuition deposit is required as a means of confirming one's intention to attend Florida Tech. **The tuition deposit is due by May 1.** Students admitted after April 1, or for the spring or summer terms, should submit payment within 30 days of the date on the acceptance letter. The deposit guarantees a place in the entering class in the indicated major and is applied to the student's first semester tuition.

TRANSCRIPTS AND TRANSFER CREDITS: All freshman students (including students with fewer than 30 college semester hours completed) **must** provide the Office of Undergraduate Admission a final, official high school transcript that includes final semester grades, date of graduation, official signature and school seal. Students who have earned college credit while in high school (dual enrollment) should have the college send an official transcript to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. All transfer students must provide official, final college transcripts from all colleges or universities attended.

HOUSING: A student's housing assignment will not be processed until he or she remits tuition and housing deposits. First-year students coming to Florida Tech directly after graduating from high school are required to live on campus. Students may register for housing through Panther Pass.

MEAL PLAN: All freshman resident students who have earned fewer than 24 credit hours are required to participate in a meal plan for the fall and spring semesters. Details of the meal program options are available through Panther Pass. All other students are not required to select a meal plan, but may do so if desired.

HEALTH FORMS: Students must satisfy the mandatory immunization requirement prior to enrollment or must participate in campus-

based clinics. Flight students should be aware of the Federal Aviation Administration medical certification requirements. A supplemental checklist has been provided for flight students, who should complete and return it as soon as possible.

ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE: Students whose first language is not English must have a TOEFL or IELTS score on file with the Office of Undergraduate Admission. For unconditional enrollment, students must achieve at least 550 on the paper-based TOEFL, 213 on the computer-based TOEFL (CBT), 79 on the Internet-based TOEFL (IBT), or 6.5 on the IELTS. Students may be granted conditional enrollment by achieving 133 or better on the CBT, 45 or better on the IBT, or 4.5 or better on the IELTS. Students who do not meet any of the above requirements will be required to enroll in the ELS Center at Florida Tech instead of an academic program, which presents significant financial ramifications and changes to immigration documentation (if applicable). Please note that all of the above testing requirements are waived for students who have spent three years at (and graduated from) a U.S. high school, who have successfully completed 20 or more credit hours (including one course in English) at another college or university, or who have scored a 4 or higher on an International Baccalaureate (IB) or Advanced Placement English Composition (AP) test.

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS/FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY: The student is responsible for knowing the official rules and regulations of Florida Tech and the regulations governing the payment of tuition and fees, which may be found online at www.fit.edu/registrar/paymentpolicy. Enrollment is considered an acceptance of all the conditions specified.

ADMISSION PUBLICITY FORM: Each student is encouraged to complete the Admission Publicity form (reverse) for the purpose of announcing his or her plans to enroll at Florida Institute of Technology.

NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION: A mandatory New Student Orientation is conducted during the days immediately preceding the beginning of each semester. Further information about orientation may be found through Panther Pass.

PLACEMENT EXAMS: First-year students are required to complete placement exams to determine your appropriate courses in communication and in mathematics. These exams will be available online via Panther Pass and must be completed by the date specified.

DECLINATION/DEFERMENT OF ADMISSION OFFER: Students who choose not to accept Florida Tech's offer of admission and students who wish to change their enrollment term of entry should notify the Office of Undergraduate Admission as soon as possible, but no later than May 1.
